

POOL RULES

TO ENSURE THE CONTINUED ENJOYMENT AND SAFETY OF OUR POOL AND SPA AREA,

THE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES AND RULES HAVE BEEN ESTABLISHED.

- 1. Only Association members, residents and their guests may use the pool/spa facilities. Each adult member is permitted to bring up to three guests. Anyone registered between the ages of 14-17 is not permitted to bring non-resident guests unless accompanied by an adult.
- 2. <u>Swim Hours*</u>: Adults only: 5 a.m. to 9 a.m. and 9 p.m. to 11 p.m. Anyone: 9 a.m. to 9 p.m.
 - *Closed daily, for janitorial services, for approximately one (1) hour between the hours of 9 a.m. and 10 a.m. Additionally, because of heavy usage during summer months, the pool will be closed Monday morning until noon for post-weekend safety and health maintenance. Exception: On Mondays which are part of a three-day holiday weekend, the pool will be kept open all day.
- 3. <u>Age Restrictions</u>: Anyone under 18 is not permitted in the pool/spa area without the accompaniment of an adult member, with the following exception: those between the ages of 14-17 may do so after being registered with the Marina Hills Recreation Center. Anyone under eight is not permitted in the spa at any time.
- 4. <u>Safety</u>: As no lifeguard is on duty, it is the parents' responsibility to oversee the safety of anyone under 18 and guests. Safety breaks: The pool will be cleared for ten minutes at 12 noon, 2 p.m. and 4 p.m. during peak summer months. Remember: No diving is allowed.
- Food, Drinks, Etc.: Do not bring glass containers or bottles into pool area; drinks must be in plastic or paper containers. Food is allowed at the tables, or in upper food area only. All litter must be disposed of properly.
- 6. Equipment & Games: Roller skating, bicycles, skateboarding, scooters and similar activities are not allowed in the pool/spa area. Pool toys, water pistols, water balloons, flotation devices and such are not permitted during peak summer hours (10 a.m. to 5 p.m.) from Memorial Day through Labor Day. Horseplay, chicken fighting and standing, sitting or diving from others' shoulders is not allowed at anytime. Soft toys only allowed during peak pool usage (10 a.m. to 5 p.m.) or at the discretion of the pool monitors. Strollers and wheelchairs are, of course, permitted. All persons must keep off lap-lane lines to avoid the possibility of costly repairs.

- 7. <u>Pets</u>: Pets are not allowed in the pool/spa area.
- 8. <u>Monitors</u>: Although pool monitors will be on duty during the summer season, our insurance coverage limits responsibility to parents and guardians.
- 9. <u>Security</u>: Make sure gates close properly behind you after entering or exiting pool area.

Bathroom Etiquette

- 1. Parents should see that anyone under the age of eight years old use the bathroom BEFORE entering the pool; anyone under the age of eight years old should also be reminded periodically to take bathroom breaks. An accident (feces) in the pool requires the pool to be closed and remain closed for up to 24 hours.
- 2. Anyone three years old and younger must wear a rubber cover over diaper swimsuit/swim trunks. Make sure to dispose of diapers in designed receptacles.

Registration for 14 - 17-year old's

Either you or a guardian is asked to bring anyone between the ages of 14-17 to the clubhouse; also take birth certificates or school certificates verifying dates of birth. An ID photo of each person between the ages of 14-17 will be taken at this time.
